



Must-see local history course

[History]

(Day 1)

1 Chiba Park

This large park well-known to the citizens of Chiba City, lets you experience nature during the four seasons, as well as boating. The Oga Lotus—the oldest flower in the world, discovered in Chiba City—is in bloom in the beginning of summer, with as many as 700 flowers blooming in peak periods.

2 Chiba City Folk Museum

The museum exhibits various materials related to the history of the area, including the history of the noble Chiba clan, which founded the town of Chiba. The museum holds many special exhibitions related to the local area, and you can see a sweeping view of Chiba City from the observation deck.


Tourist facility

Chiba City Museum of Art

This unique art museum is a preserved prewar bank building of Renaissance revival architecture enclosed in a new building. In addition to the splendid selection of special exhibitions, certain highlights from the 10,000-piece collection are always on display and can be seen in the permanent exhibition room. These include Ukiyoe (woodblock prints), other early modern Japanese paintings, prints and modern art related to the Boso area.

The museum can be enjoyed by all ages, with projects where visitors can take part in creating a space with artists, a library with over 4,500 works and a workshop room.



Myoken Shrine (Chiba Shrine)

This is a head shrine dedicated to Myoken, the God of the North Star who controls people's stars (or fates). Myoken was the guardian deity of the Chiba Clan, which helped Minamoto no Yoritomo and contributed greatly to the establishment of the Kamakura shogunate. Many worshipers visit looking for two divine providences: warding off evil and bringing in good fortune by expelling bad stars and guiding the worshiper to good stars, and protection from all sorts of disasters and misfortunes. This is the only multistoried Shinto shrine in Japan.




Sponsoring requirements
